2. Write down your ideas and draw some designs. Just like designers do, think about the material and how 'it will be done.'

3. If you can, make the face mask according to your design. If it is too complex or if you do not have the necessary tools and skills, work out your design in greater detail and in a larger format and provide it with explanations.

4. Present the resulting designs to others and talk about how and why your personal face mask would look like. If you want, tell others about how you feel about face masks.

5. And then take a look at the attachment and think about the images you will find there!

In the pictures, you can see the design of face masks or respirators designed by contemporary designers. Note that the original protection element has changed into a fashion accessory, for which parameters other than functionality are also important.
