Registration & Check-in

Carolina Room – 1st Floor, Arts Centre (Konvikt) (Univerzitní 3)

Monday 21 July (from 8:00 am) – regular check-in is available from 8:00 to 18:00 every day

Registration for all in-person participants – both active (presenting) and passive (not-presenting) – will be open Monday—Thursday from 8.00 to 18.00 at the main venue: the Arts Centre of Palacký University Olomouc (Konvikt). Please visit the Carolina Room to check in, pick up your congress materials, and receive any necessary assistance. You'll receive your badge, printed programme, map, and welcome gifts.

Due to high summer temperatures, we strongly encourage all participants to **stay well hydrated**.

- **Drinking water** is available in all university buildings, including the **Arts Centre** (**Konvikt**), where the congress takes place.
- You can **refill your bottle** at designated **refreshment points** (10 locations available throughout the day), or use **tap water** in rooms and restrooms.
- Please remember to drink regularly and make use of the chill-out zones for rest and relaxation. These are located inside the building, in the courtyard, and in the gardens (parkán).

What is Not Included

Participants are responsible for arranging their own **dinners**, which can be enjoyed at the Konvikt Bistro or at one of the many restaurants and shops throughout the city. On **Friday**, all meals are self-arranged.

If you're joining a bus trip or excursion, you are welcome to bring your own snacks, and there will also be opportunities to purchase food and refreshments on site.

Each evening, you are invited to enjoy our cultural programme and relax in the garden (parkán) of the Arts Centre (Konvikt) – complete with live music and informal networking.

Travel – nearest airport etc.

If landing to Prague, the trip to Olomouc is very straightforward, participants can take a train from Prague to Olomouc which takes about 2.5 hours and goes more than once every hour. There is a shuttle bus AE (Airport Express) that goes every 20-30 mins from Prague airport to Prague train station. When landing to Vienna, participants can take a direct train to Olomouc or a Student Agency bus that takes about 3-4 hours with changing in Brno.

All bus, train, and public transport connections can be found at idos.cz

How to get to / around Olomouc

Olomouc can be easily reached by train or by bus. You can find all the connections on idos.cz (all public transport in the Czech Republic) or on the website of Czech Railways or RegioJet or Leo Express, where you can also buy train tickets and make reservations.

Getting around Olomouc is also easy: either on foot or by public transport (buses or trams; information can be found on the website of Dopravní podnik města Olomouce).

The venue of the congress — the Palacký University Art Centre / Umělecké centrum UP, Univerzitní 3, is in the heart of the city. The closest tram stop is Náměstí Republiky.

We highly recommend that you use mapy.cz, which is also available as a mobile app. Maps can be downloaded or they can be used online.
